## **Volunteer Project: Bi-lingual Conservation Publications**

### **Background/Introduction:**

Since Hillsborough County has a large urban population, the District feels that schools and other community organizations may benefit from having various brochures and booklets available to them in different languages.

**Project responsibilities:** Contact partner organizations to see if there is an interest to have bi-lingual conservation materials. Collect copies of the various documents to be converted into other languages. Research the various languages spoken in Hillsborough County by contacting the cities (Nashua & Manchester). Find out what languages the publications should be printed in to benefit their students. Research grants to secure funding for the project. Write grant proposal to secure funding.

**Project requirements:** Upon completion of the project, a grant proposal will be written to print various conservation publications in multiple languages. The District Manager will be able to take over the project once the grant has been approved. Conservation publications will be distributed to partner organizations for distribution as they see fit.

Anticipated time for project will be discussed with student and advisor.

**Brief description of organization:** The Hillsborough County Conservation District represents soil and water conservation at the local level. Formed in 1946 as a sub-division of the State of New Hampshire, State Statute 430:8, the District is managed by a volunteer Board of Supervisors. The District works with farmers, forest landowners, landowners, schools, and municipalities to promote the use, protection, and conservation of natural resources on both private and public land, both rural and urban. Our conservation programs in Hillsborough County are carried out through public education and the implementation of Best Management Practices (BMPs).
